- -- Fatal accident occured yesterday around 1:00 pm
- -- Involved delivery truck carrying Avon products
- -- Involved a blue, 4-door Chevy station wagon with 3 occupants
- -- Driver of Chevy dead on the scene
- -- Two passengers also seriously injured and listed in critical condition
- -- Passengers at Mt. Clemens General Hospital
- -- Truck driver received minor injuries
- -- All three Chevy passengers were thrown from the vehicle (from State Police report)
- -- Accident occured at 32 mile and Cypress Creek Road in norther Macomb County (Armada Township)
- -- Truck was travelling west on 32 mile, Chevy northbound on Cypress Creek
- -- Truck broadsided Chevy in middle of intersection
- -- Passing motorist found victims and notified police via cellular phone (from State Police report)
- -- Area is rural farmland. Cornstalks may have obstructed view of Chevy.
- -- Victim identified Timothy Leary 47, Port Huron, pronounced DOS
